

Welcome to Karjaan lukio!

Karjaan lukio is a Finnish-language upper secondary school in Raasepori (<https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Raseborg>) with about 140 students aged between 16-19. The studies usually take three years, after which our graduates are eligible for universities. We frequently co-operate with other upper secondary schools in the region as well as Raasepori Conservatory, Raasepori Dance Institute and Karjaa Secondary School, with which we share the premises. We also have international projects in Germany, South Africa and Switzerland (CERN) as well as local projects, for example in entrepreneurial activity.

The amount of students is relatively small, which allows the staff to assist and counsel them according to their individual needs. Studies at Karjaan lukio are divided into three categories: obligatory, advanced and applied courses. A school year consists of five periods and at least four courses must be taken during each period. The subjects at our school include natural sciences, humanities (history, psychology, philosophy etc.), languages, religion or ethics, visual arts, music and physical education. The languages include English, Swedish, German, French and Spanish.

Our students belong to the students' union, which organizes different activities and works to enhance the students' well-being. Members of the board of the union also attend teachers' meetings. Volunteer tutors offer guidance to first-year students.
